the legal, policy and practical actions that governments are taking to respond to modern slavery

We want to end modern slavery globally within our generation. To achieve this, we need every business to get on board. Every business has modern slavery in their supply chains – but only if you start looking, you will start finding.

The Global Slavery Index is a tool to help businesses identify modern slavery risk within their supply chains, including by:

- 1 / UNDERSTAND THE ISSUE: review country and regional studies to gain a general understanding of your business' modern slavery risks.
- 2 / MAP YOUR RISK PROFILE:
 filter prevalence data to map your risk
 profile for those regions or countries
 from which your business sources
 their goods and services. This data
 can be integrated into your internal
 risk assessment procedures.
- 3 / UNDERSTAND THE FRAMEWORKS: assess what legal frameworks and policy responses governments have put in place to respond to modern slavery within your operation or sourcing countries.
